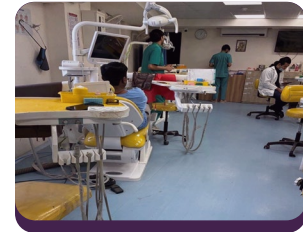

Livelihood & Agriculture

Creating sustainable livelihoods through skill-building, training, and agricultural support for farmers.

UDP (Urea Deep Placement) Project (Haryana)

- **21** Farmers (Baseline)
- **26.2%** Increase in Yield
- **46.1%** Reduction in Water Usage
- **~30%** Reduction in Urea Usage
- **19.2%** Price Premium for Produce
- **SROI: 1:1.7 (Year 1) → Projected 1:30.4 (Long Term)**

After: Higher income, sustainable practices, improved climate resilience



GHG Emissions + Productivity

Key Insights from UDP Study

Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Impact

~69 tCO₂e total emissions reduction across 71.5 acres

~30% reduction in emission intensity

~0.96 tCO₂e/acre reduction (3.19 → 2.23 tCO₂e/acre)



What's Driving Emission Reduction?

- Lower N₂O emissions (major contributor)
 - Literature: 61%–84% reduction
- Reduced CH₄ emissions
 - Up to 40% reduction in flooded paddy systems
- 66% reduction in urea use (6.4 MT saved)
 - Directly lowers fertilizer-linked emissions
- 46% reduction in water use
 - Less irrigation → lower energy use → lower CO₂ emissions



Energy–Water–Carbon Link

- Reduced irrigation → lower pumping hours
- ~60+ tCO₂e avoided due to reduced energy consumption
- Demonstrates strong water–energy–carbon nexus benefits



Productivity Gains (Breaking the Trade-off)

- +27% yield increase (30.6 → 38.9 quintals/acre)
- +596 quintals total production gain
- Achieved without increasing inputs



System-Level Transformation

- Higher output + lower emissions simultaneously
- –66% fertilizer | –46% water | –30% emissions
- Shows UDP breaks the classic productivity vs sustainability trade-off
